Creative Prayer: When it's dark, head outside as a family and look up to the night sky. You could go on a walk together to find somewhere with less street lighting so you can see the stars more clearly. Be quiet together for 1 minute thinking about how big space is and how our God is bigger still. Then whisper to God something you're worried about right now. He is bigger than big but can still hear your whispers and still cares about everything in our lives. Afterwards pause again in case you catch anything back from God.
